

# Application and Requirements for the Lake Orion National Art Honor Society

## Due: Wednesday, November 8, 2023

- To remain a member in good standing, a member must pay \$5 in dues each year. This amount will be collected by the Art Club treasurer along with this printed and signed NAHS form, then sent to nationals.
- Students must recommit each year. This is a one- year commitment. We will have a spring tea in the sculpture garden to pass out cords to seniors. All NAHS members must attend.
- Complete a minimum of 8 art related service hours during the school year and they must be turned in to the Assignments tab on teams.
- Attendance is required at a minimum of 8 Art club/NAHS meetings and events throughout the school year to maintain membership and privileges in the LOHS NAHS. If you fail to make your commitments to the NAHS, you may still be in the LOHS Art club. You must record your attendance in teams for the Art Club and NAHS events you attend in the Teams-Assignments tab. If it is not in there, it did not happen.
- All members must donate 1 piece of art to the Fall dinner auction **AND** 1 piece in the Spring art auction. Attendance at both events is mandatory.
- To graduate with NAHS honors and earn the right to wear a cord, pin, or tassel at graduation, a member must remain in good standing until their graduation date. They must complete the requirements **senior** year to receive cords. Hours must be completed by April 17<sup>th</sup>. Freshman-Juniors have until the end of the school year.
- Students must provide at least one hour of Art tutoring to another student in need in a beginning level class. This maybe done at an art club and evidence must be submitted in Teams-Assignments. If tutoring cannot be fulfilled, an additional hour (9 hours in total) of community service can be completed.
- All school rules apply at all Art Club/NAHS events and meetings.
- Junior and Senior members will email a photo and statement for a piece to Mr. Rimi by the end of November to enter in the NAHS show.
- You must sign up for the remind texts, so that you receive updates. This is your responsibility.
